Conditions of entry*

Closing date: Entries will close on the 1st October 2010 or earlier if all available places are taken.

Fees: Fees are as stated on the entry form and they must accompany the entry form, refunds for cancellation will not be made after the 1st October 2010.

Eligibility:

Men: Entry is available to amateur golfers, aged 55 years or older, who are financial members of an affiliated Veteran Golf Club, Group or Association.

Ladies: Entry is available to partners of male entrants and Lady Veteran Golfers.

All entrants must have a current Golf Australia handicap

Handicaps: Maximum handicaps Men – 36 Ladies -45, will remain as they commenced for the 54 hole events, they may be reduced for daily events.

Grades: The match committee will determine the handicap limits for the three grades for men and two divisions for ladies when entries are finalized.

Rules: Golf will be played in accordance with R & A rules and the local rules applicable to the course being played.

Cards and Protests: Must be lodged within 15 minutes of conclusion of the players round.

Events: The championships are a 54 hole stroke event, in three grades. Ladies will play a 54 hole stableford event, in two divisions. Daily events will be held in conjunction.

Tied Scores: Should scores be tied at the conclusion of play a sudden death play off will be used to determine the AVGU Champion. All other tied scores will be ranked in count back order.

Trophies: Competitors can win only one major trophy.

Dress Code: All competitors must be correctly attired; smart casual dress is required for the Welcome and Presentation Functions.

Hire Carts and Buggies: A limited number is available at each club and they will be allocated in order of medical priority or receipt of entry form. Hire fees payable at each club on the day of play.

Liability: Competitors play at their own risk and must have their own insurance protection, the organisers will not be liable for any personal injury or loss of or damage to any property
